

Annual Report of the School

This report is comprised of the achievements made during the year 2019. In the area of academics, this year too, the results of X and XII held in March 2019 has once again brought laurels to our school by achieving remarkable scores. X Board came out with 100% result and XII Board students: Harpreet Kaur from science stream got 84.6% , the most significantly, Jasleen Kaur and Harmanpreet Kaur from commerce got 91.8% and 90.6% respectively.

Strenuous exercise and interest in games is an outlet for the vigor of youth. Ample opportunities were provided to our school children to play and prove their mettle in various sports and games at school, district, state and National level. District level games were held from 03-09-2019 to 14-09- 2019. In handball, U-17 girls got 1st position and in Kho- Kho, U-19 girls got 3rd position. Overall 9 girls and 2 boys got selected for state level games. In 65th Punjab state school games, overall 42 girls and 51boys selected for District level games. Athletic tournament at District level was held on 23-10-2019 and 24-10-2019 at Guru Arjun Dev Sports Stadium, Tarn Taran. From boys, Gurjeet Singh got 1st position in 1 event, 3rd position in 2 events and Anmolpreet Singh and Samarpreet Singh got 5th position in 1 event. From girls, Rimpal Kaur got 1st position in 2 events and 2nd position in 1 event, Amreen Kaur and Navdeep Kaur got 2nd position in 1 event .In Athletic tournament, Rimpal Kaur got 1st position in High Jump and got selected for National Tournament. In addition to this, the most interestingly she got 1st position in 200 meter, 400 meter and high jump in Reliance National Finals.

Co-curricular activities provide children opportunities to showcase their talents. House wise competitions were conducted throughout the year in English extempore, recitation, group song, group dance etc. A number of competitions were conducted in September in connection with Swachhata Pakhwara and both students and teachers took part in the competitions. Days of National and International importance like, World Population Day, Republic Day, Independence Day, Vigilance Awareness Week, Rashtriya Ekta Diwas, World Maths Day were celebrated to promote secularism, unity, harmony and to spread the message of peace and universal brotherhood.

Participation in activities under hubs of learning was a great success. A series of activities was constructed in which our students participated enthusiastically. The whole conduction was creative, exploratory and remarkable for its learners and the most satisfactory experience for its teachers.

With the sole purpose of updating teachers' knowledge the school hosted a series of teachers' workshop. It was an attempt which inclusively engulfed various significant aspects like moral values, life skills by CBSE, meditation and stress management. Apart from this, our teachers are made a part of the training sessions and workshops happening at other school. Attendee teachers further share the knowledge with other fellow teachers widening the sphere of wisdom.
